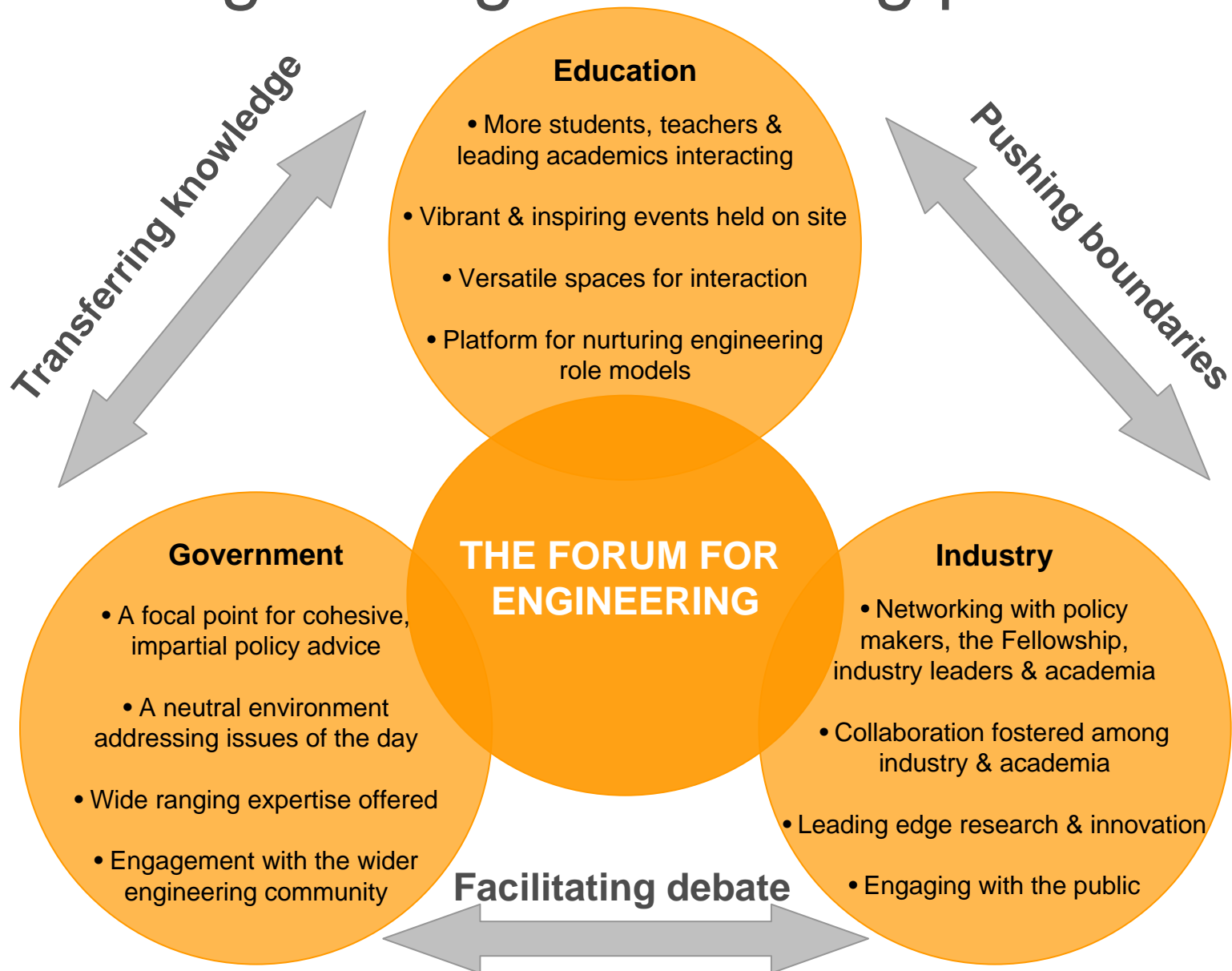
## **The Academy's vision:**

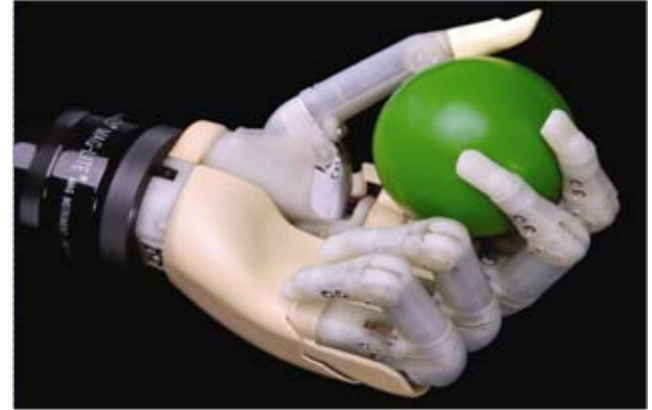

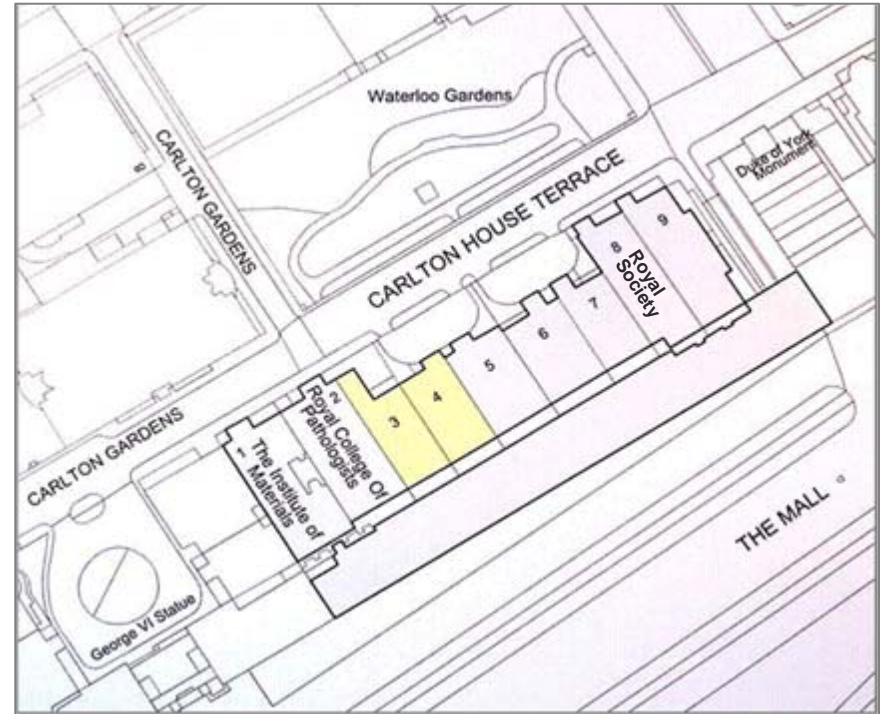
