Garden Entrance and Sinuous Bridge at 3 Carlton House Terrace

The 'S'-shaped bridge fuses engineering, art and architecture to create a spectacular landmark, showcasing innovation and design excellence but still being sensitive to the historic external landscape.

Balancing heritage with modernity, the bridge will lead visitors into The Royal Academy of Engineering, across a landscaped garden based on the designs of Decimus Burton (1800-1881), one of the original architects of Carlton House Terrace.
