**The Engineering Diploma will be offered at KS4 (Levels 1 and 2) and at post 16 (Level 1, 2, and 3)**

The Engineering in Southwark and Lambeth will be offered at Levels 1&2 at KS4 and at Levels 1.2 &3 post 16. Schools not listed above can access the diploma programme at LS4 through the existing school links programme at Southwark and Lambeth Colleges, provided they offer the additional and specialist learning, functional skills and the project.
