Renewable energy, sustainable engineering

Sgurr Energy has worked on projects for non-grid-connected power systems specially designed for remote locations and capacities of only a few hundred kilowatts (kW), right up to some of the world's largest renewable energy developments with capacities of thousands of megawatts (MW). They have worked on onshore wind farm projects across the globe, including Europe's largest wind farm on Eaglesham Moor near Glasgow and a pioneering 50-MW project in Inner Mongolia, China. Technical Director and co-Founder Ian Irvine will discuss the need for sustainable energy and the challenges to be faced in the context of global climate change.
